What is required for hosting a student?

As a Lake Shore Public Schools host family, we expect you to provide a supportive home environment and room and board to our exchange students.

Host families are:

- Able to provide culturally engaging experiences for the student
- Eager to include the student in their family and community
- Interested in learning about other cultures
- Warm, welcoming and open-minded

Host family requirements:

- Host student willing to escort exchange student during school day
- Inclusion with family activities including costs
- May share room with same-sex family member, but must have own bed
- Parental supervision
- Provide meals – school lunches will be provided
- The German students' school has requested no gun-related activities (i.e. hunting or laser tag).
