Weeks one and three are at Masonic Heights Elementary School in the Lake Shore School District and week two will be at Lighthouse Elementary in the Anchor Bay School District (free bus transportation is provided)

Week 1- The Chinese students stay at the dorm and get to know their American friends during day camp.

Weeks 2 and 3- The Chinese students will live with the host families to share in a family cultural experience after day camp and on weekends.

Highlights of Camp- At camp, American students will have morning enrichment classes while the Chinese students work on their English speaking skills. In the afternoon, the schedule is full of fun activities and field trips for all the students to enjoy together!
