Paul Landry has been employed with United Cerebral Palsy of Metropolitan Detroit, since July 1996. Currently, Paul serves as a Community Work Incentive Counselor.

In the fall of 2012, Paul started a fee for service program aimed at the state's Vocational Rehabilitation and Commission for the Blind agencies to provide individualized benefit analysis to individuals who wish to have a better understanding of how their Social Security and other public benefits would be affected as they return to work.

Paul also manages the Work Incentive Planning & Assistance (WIPA) Project which is a nationwide program funded through the Social Security Administration. Paul had been a Benefit Counselor on a similar project which was formally known as the Benefit Planning Assistance & Outreach (BPA&O) Project.
