Good Evening Fellow Shorians,

As you may be aware, on the ballot this Tuesday, February 27<sup>th</sup> is Lake Shore Public Schools Non-Homestead Renewal. This millage is a major funding piece for Lake Shore that has been in place since 1994 and was last renewed in 2014. The Non-Homestead Operating Millage applies only to second homes and commercial properties and does not impact a homeowners primary residence. Revenue from this millage accounts for \$2.6 million of our annual operating budget and is used for salaries, benefits, operations, materials, and supplies. In short it is a vital piece of our budget.
